**Old Business:**

1. Approval of the September financial statement.
2. Approval of the October financial statement.
3. Approval with corrections to the October minutes.

**Follow Up:**

1. Mayor Thomas stated that the topic of the Brown Oil spill was ongoing and had not heard anything further on the situation.
2. Mayor Thomas confirmed that BellSouth does have the answering service with the option of voice mail. Mayor Thomas stated that he was not sure if voice mail was needed for each councilman or needed only as a general service for the Town Hall.
3. Mayor Thomas reminded everyone that the BellSouth Mobility contract will end December 16. He recommended that a different, less expensive plan be looked at for the new contract.
4. Due the absence of Councilman Carter, a discussion of Recreational Grant Application was postponed until the December meeting.
5. Mayor Thomas reported that last month he issued two certificates of occupancy and had a meeting set up to check out a house at Hickory Lake for qualification of a Certificate of Occupancy. He also reported that he had a meeting set up to discuss a building permit near Ray's Church Road.

6. Mayor Thomas stated that the window downstairs needs repairing and that the door needs repairing so that it would lock. He said that he would contact P. Keilman to do repairs. A call was received reporting vandalism of someone painting graffiti and throwing a rock through the window. Mayor Thomas also reported that he would purchase a new pad lock for the door.


7. Mayor Thomas recommended that landscaping be done at the new fire station facility. He recommended that the plants be purchased from the Morgan County High School Ag Department.

8. Councilwoman Dawe stated that a "Private Drive" sign is needed on Hilsboro. There was also a request to pave the drive because of erosion. Mayor Thomas stated that he would ride out and check the erosion problem.

9. Councilwoman Dawe asked about the Mayor hiring a secretary. Mayor Thomas stated that it was in his plans to do so.

With no further business to be discussed, a motion was made by Councilman Sosebee and was second by Councilwoman Dawe to adjourn the November meeting, all approved.
