Public Hearing:

The Mayor and Council held the first hearing for the 2003 Millage Rate. It was recommended that the millage rate be left the same as last year. This would leave the millage rate at 1.806

Monthly Business:

1. Approval of the **Financial Statement** for the month of **May**. A motion to approve was made by Councilman Ivie. A second to the motion was made by Councilman Johnson. All councilmembers present approved the motion.
2. Approval of the **Financial Statement** for the month of **June**. A motion to approve was made by Councilman Ivie. A second to the motion was made by Councilman Cape. All councilmembers present approved the motion.
3. Approval of the **Financial Statement** for the month of **July**. A motion to approve was made by Councilman Cape. A second to the motion was made by Councilman Johnson. All council members present approved the motion.

4. Approval of the Draft Copy of the June minutes. Motion to approve with corrections made by Councilman Johnson. A second to the motion made by Councilman Ivie. All members present approved the motion.

5. There was no meeting held in July due to lack of a quorum.

Old Business:

1. **City Park:** Mayor Thomas and Council members discussed prices for the basketball court, along with having a new sign put at the park. It was also mentioned that the walking path needs to be patched where grass is growing.

2. **Speed Breaks:** Mayor Thomas reported that there had been two speed breaks put on sections of Jefferson and Plantation. There was a complaint that the speed limit signs were put too close to the speed breaks. The Mayor noted that some signs had not yet come in. The need for "No Thru Trucks" signs were still needed on Jefferson and Plantation and also one on Hillsboro Road.

Suzanne Beall presented a petition for speed breaks on Jefferson Road. Ms. Beall had obtained 11 signatures.

Mayor's Update:

1. Councilwoman Dawe reported that a firm from Alabama wants to set up a landfill between Choice Johnson Road and the Apalachee River. Councilwoman Dawe feels that the town needs to take a stand.

Mayor Thomas stated that a resolution was needed and that he would prepare one to be adopted at next month's meeting.

2. Resident, Douglas Northrop reported that the sidewalk was complete in front of Hickory Ridge subdivision.

With no further business to discuss a motion was made by Councilman Ivie to conclude the August meeting. A second was made to the motion by Councilman Cape. All council members present approved the motion.
