At this called meeting regarding the new town hall, Ms. Tiffany Phillips (representing Berry Coating) brought paint samples for council to consider for the new Town Hall. She stated that she was only prepared to present neutral colors, but Council Member Dawe stated that she would like to see something brighter and more welcoming. Ms. Phillips will have a sample sent to the new building with a brighter color, and council will view and select. Council Member Dotterweich expressed a preference for neutral with white trim. Ms. Phillips stated that the colors on the color wheel might be a little different than what is painted on the wall. The subject will be discussed more and decided at the next meeting.

Council discussed installing tile for the bathrooms, rather than the vinyl that is on the plan (\$2500 to upgrade), and Council Member Carlson made the motion to install the tile. Council Member Presley made the second. The vote was unanimous.

Council discussed lighting zones (different lights for different switches), dimmable lighting, and led lighting.

Council Member Presley shared with council many interesting ideas regarding computer preparations and hardware quotes. Council discussed the estimates and suggestions from Athens Micro. Other topics discussed were electronic door locks, wifi, cameras, maintenance fees, projector/screen/tv, determining current and future needs, etc. Athens Micro will continue to install the cables, and Council Member Presley will do more research for the town.

There was no other business, and Council Member Dotterweich made the motion to adjourn. Council Member Dawe made the second, and the vote was unanimous.
